Position Overview:

Reporting to the Course Superintendent, the Senior Grounds Person is responsible for maintaining the beauty and playability of the golf course and surrounding property. This upper-level position is integral to maintaining the course and providing an exceptional experience to guests.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Operate various groundskeeping equipment and power tools up to and including tractors, trailers and excavators
- Perform mowing duties on all aspects of the golf course and property
- Participate in and/or supervise course renovation projects
- · Participate in projects involving turf, sodding and seeding
- Assist in cultural work such as aerating, slicing, tining, topdressing, and applying granular fertilizer
- Identify and control weeds, pests and diseases in turf
- · Assist in the repair of the irrigation system as needed
- Assist with managing soil moisture data
- Daily course set up such as filling divots on tees and fairways, and setting tees and pins
- Maintain the on course bunkers
- Perform other duties associated with daily golf course and property maintenance such as brush and debris removal, hand watering, operating irrigation controllers etc.
- · Maintain a clean working environment
- Maintain daily record keeping and paperwork
- Other duties as assigned

Skills and Abilities:

- Team-oriented
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Ability to lead and positively influence others
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Strong attention to detail
- · Ability to work in all weather conditions
- Physically able to carry out the functions of the position
- Knowledge of golf and/or the ability to play the game is an asset

- Three or more years of experience on a golf course maintenance team
- Valid Basic First Aid, with CPR, and AED Certification, or equivalent will be required to be maintained during employment

- Knowledge of irrigation systems and pest management techniques is required
- Valid Forklift Certification is an asset
