



Irrigation Technician

Position Overview: Capilano Golf and Country Club is seeking a motivated and enthusiastic Irrigation Technician to support the management of its unique gravity-fed irrigation system. Reporting to the Course Superintendent and Senior Assistant Superintendent, and working closely with the Senior Irrigation Technician, this role assists in overseeing all irrigation operations, including repairs, scheduling, and water management across the golf course.

Main Responsibilities:

- Monitor and adjust the irrigation systems for optimal coverage.
- Perform ongoing repairs to the existing PVC system as needed.
- Perform scheduled maintenance on six Pressure Reducing Valves (PRVs) to ensure consistent pressure and flow.
- Assist with nightly irrigation planning and monitor overall water use in line with the club's Water Use Plan.
- Maintain irrigation inventory and monitor the health of the club's two man-made irrigation lakes.
- Work with the club's Irrigation Consultant to implement best practices and support intern training in irrigation tasks.
- Stay current with industry trends through education, seminars, and networking events.
- Support other course maintenance operations and represent the department professionally at all times.

Club Information: Constructed in 1938 by esteemed Canadian golf course architect Stanley Thompson, Capilano is a private 18-hole facility located in West Vancouver, British Columbia and is open for play year-round. Capilano is consistently ranked in the top 10 golf courses in Canada and ranked in the top 100 golf courses in the world outside the United States.

The Club is dedicated to the ongoing restoration and enhancement of the golf course through a comprehensive Course Long Range Master Plan that has been in place for several years. Following a recent upgrade to the mainline feed and installation of a booster pump, the club is preparing to implement a phased Irrigation Master Plan in the near future. Operating from a state-of-the-art Maintenance and Fleet Facility, our high-performance Course and Grounds team, comprised of up to 40 dedicated professionals, takes pride in producing exceptional playing conditions.

Qualifications:

- A degree or two-year diploma from a recognized institution in turfgrass management or related field.
- Valid BC Driver's license or equivalent.
