Overview:

The **Golf Course Equipment Technician** will be responsible for maintaining, diagnosing, and repairing a wide range of golf course maintenance equipment, including mowers, tractors, utility vehicles, and other machinery. The ideal candidate will possess strong technical abilities, a passion for golf course operations, and a commitment to ensuring the equipment is in top working condition to maintain the quality of the course.

Job Responsibilities include:

- Inspect, adjust, diagnose, service, and repair all golf course equipment including mowers, greens rollers, aerators, tractors and utility vehicles
- Conduct diagnostic assessments to identify mechanical, electrical, and hydraulic issues and determine appropriate repairs or replacement parts
- Prioritize equipment repair and maintenance work to ensure maximum efficiency
- Maintain detailed service records for all equipment, including maintenance schedules, repairs, and part replacements
- Ensure all equipment is properly calibrated and function efficiently to meet operational standards
- Schedule and implement an approved preventative maintenance program
- Maintain a clean and organized work environment, including managing tools, equipment, and parts inventory
- Provide input and recommendations into equipment purchase decisions
- Perform welding and small-scale fabrication
- Stay updated on new equipment technologies and repair techniques to enhance efficiency and effectiveness
- Adhere to all safety protocols and always ensure safe operation of equipment
